

**Kingston Upon Hull is the principle city of the East Riding of Yorkshire some 34 miles south east of York.** Nestling north of the Humber estuary Hull is of great commercial importance as the main port for the north east of England. Historically linked with freedom and liberty, it was a Hull politician and statesman, William Wilberforce who campaigned tirelessly for the abolition of slavery, something that Hull citizens are still proud of today. Hull has a great deal to attract the Modern visitor. 'The Deep', celebrates her association with the sea and is Europe's biggest subterranean aquarium. Wilberforce House, and the Whaling Museum afford a glimpse into the past, while the ultra modern Marina and Quay shopping districts point towards the future.

**The EAC summer school takes place at the Lawns Campus in a residential suburb approximately 15 minutes bus ride from the city centre.** The Lawns offers a large number of single study bedrooms with a good ratio of shared bathroom facilities. The centre also has classrooms, a pool room, a bar and an area for discos. Laundry rooms, a computer room with internet access and a TV room are also available on-site. There are 2 tennis courts, a football pitch and ample open areas for outdoor games. Excellent indoor sports facilities are also available close to the campus. The village of Cottingham has excellent local amenities: banks, shops, and post office are all within easy walking distance.

## Accommodation

The Lawns offers a large number of spacious single study bedrooms, each with its own wash basin. The accommodation is laid out over several connecting halls. Each hall has 5 blocks and each block has 18 single rooms and 3 twin rooms over 3 floors. On each floor there are shared bathroom facilities, a shared kitchen and a common area. Each Hall has its own small common room and laundry facilities. Homestay accommodation is also available with carefully selected hosts in the local area.
